Bluebell Railway Track Trek

Saturday 12th November 2016

The Bluebell Railway will be holding a sponsored walk – the Track Trek – to raise funds for two projects – ASH Accessible Steam Heritage and Operation Undercover Phase 4 – walking along the entire length of line between East Grinstead and Sheffield Park stations, a distance of eleven miles or a shorter walk of five miles between Horsted Keynes and Sheffield Park on Saturday 12th November this year.

Walking on a railway track is rough ground and stout footwear is essential along with warm and waterproof clothing. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. All children under 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult. Regrettably the Trek is not considered suitable for children under the age of seven years.

Walkers will be required to start the walk from East Grinstead between 9:00am and 10:00am with registration and safety briefings starting at East Grinstead from 8:30am. Alternatively you can park your car at Sheffield Park station and catch a complimentary bus to East Grinstead in time to start your walk before 10:00am. Registration and safety briefings at Sheffield Park take place between 8:00am and 9:00am to allow time for the bus ride to East Grinstead. At registration walkers will be expected to show sponsorship to the value of at least £25 per person or £40 for each family group (maximum two adults and three children). Walkers who raise £100 or more in sponsorship will receive a commemorative medal. If you need more sponsorship forms please photocopy this one.

For walkers starting at East Grinstead a complimentary bus service will operate to take you back to your original starting point from Sheffield Park station.

If eleven miles sounds too much then a five mile walk starting from Horsted Keynes is available with registration and safety briefings between 11:30am and 12:30pm with the walk starting immediately after registration. A complimentary bus service will operate to take you back to Horsted Keynes.

At each of the stations refreshment facilities will be available including hot drinks with hot food on sale at Horsted Keynes and Sheffield Park.
